Next meetings on Karabakh settlement to be held in Hague on March 23-25



Washington, D.C— March 21, 2014— Baku. Victoria Dementyeva – APA. “Co-chairs of the OSCE Minsk Group will hold next meetings on Karabakh settlement in The Hague on March 23-25,” U.S. co-chair of OSCE Minsk Group James Warlick wrote on his Twitter page, APA reports.

Warlick noted that they were looking forward to meeting with the Presidents and Foreign Ministers of Armenia and Azerbaijan at the Nuclear Security Summit in The Hague on March 23-25. Earlier, Azerbaijani Foreign Minister Elmar Mammadyarov told journalists that OSCE Minsk Group co-chairs had offered Azerbaijani and Armenian foreign ministers to meet on the sidelines of the Nuclear Security Summit in The Hague.

According to a reliable source, the meeting of Azerbaijani and Armenian presidents isn't scheduled within the summit in The Hague. The foreign ministers will probably meet there. Following the summit in The Hague, the co-chairs plan to visit the region in April.

The third Nuclear Security Summit, which will also be attended by Azerbaijan, will take place in The Hague on March 24-25. About 5000 delegates including 58 leaders of several countries will attend the event. Azerbaijani President has also been invited to the summit.
