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Is Your Facility Drowning? Aging Facilities & Declining Usership (0.2 CEU's)

Roundtable Discussion

Moderated by CRPA Aquatics Committee Co-Chairs, Courtney Hewett and Bailey Dailey, this roundtable discussion on aquatics facilities will be geared toward municipalities currently dealing with aging facilities or experiencing declining usership. The session will begin with a brief overview of the Town of Glastonbury's recent feasibility study for both an outdoor and indoor facility. **Participants are asked to share their statistics for the amount of passes sold or attendance at their facility and innovative ideas for increasing use and deferring maintenance costs** such as resident versus nonresident **policies**, concession sales, etc. We will discuss current trends in building a new or renovating an existing aquatics facility, what has worked and what hasn't with regard to resident and nonresident sales, and possible revenue generating ideas municipalities can use to offset costs.

About the Presenters & Moderators:

Bailey Dailey serves as the Recreation Supervisor at Winding Trails in Farmington. She is currently the CRPA Aquatics Section Co-Chair and represents CRPA on the newly formed Connecticut Legislative Task Force for Water Safety.

Bill Engle, CPRP has served as Recreation Supervisor for the Town of Glastonbury for the past 26 years where he is responsible for coordinating upgrades, maintenance needs, and the planning and marketing of all aquatic programs at one indoor and three outdoor facilities. Bill received his BS in Recreation Management from Indiana University. He has served as CRPA Treasurer since 2009 and has been a member of the CRPA Legislative Committee since 2007.

Courtney Hewett, CPRP, CPO is the Director of Parks and Recreation for the Town of Canton. She serves as the co-chair of both the CRPA Aquatics and Camp Sections and is a member of the CRPA Conference Committee.
