

One of Flint Power System's marine dealers in the State of Florida recently sold, and started engine installation on this 51' Rybovich Spencer, charter fishing boat in Ponce Inlet, FL. The boat was originally powered by twin Detroit Diesel 6V-92's, approximately 500 horsepower each.

The boat is being re-powered with twin

John Deere 6125AFM75's, tier 2, 526 horsepower each. The re-power is anticipated to increase the boat's performance tremendously by gaining approximately 5 – 8 knots at cruise speed, and top speed, while also decreasing fuel consumption by approximately 30%.
